Introduction:

This clinic is designed for those individuals

- wishing to obtain or update their combined driving officials' card
- thinking about becoming a combined driving official
- who simply want to learn more about combined driving events

The clinic will cover combined driving judge and technical delegate duties, provide examples and insights into officiating at combined driving events, as well as answer any questions participants may have.

Clinician:

Lorraine Hill is an EC Senior Combined Driving Judge and EC Competition Coach Specialist in Dressage. She is active with many facets of the horse "world" -- coaching dressage; mentoring future coaches; facilitating Equestrian Canada coaching workshops; judging combined driving; and evaluating coaches for the EC coaching certification program. She has trained and shown horses to FEI dressage levels and to Combined Driving Intermediate level. She currently trains a young dressage horse and driving pony for pleasure. She has a strong belief that the principles of dressage can be applied to the driving horse with the understanding that there are "imitations". She has officiated CDE's for over 20 years in western Canada & the northwest USA and has had amazing opportunities to work with and shadow FEI & US judges, and regularly attend the ADS official's super clinics.

Doug Orr is an ECE "S" and ADS "R" Combined Driving Technical Delegate; and has officiated as TD at numerous combined driving events in both Canada and the US for over twenty years. As an equestrian competitor, he has trained and shown horses to Intermediate Level in combined driving and Third Level in ridden Dressage. In 2010 he was honored to be invited to work with the FEI Combined Driving Stewarding team at the World Equestrian Games in Lexington.
