



# Hours On The Box Seat 2025

The Alberta Carriage Driving Association has developed the **Hours On The Box Seat** program to recognize its members' dedication to the sport of driving and to encourage young drivers to learn to drive safely with good instruction.

The program will operate on the honour system. You drive your horse or pony and log the number of hours spent on the box seat (driving speak for driver's seat) that day.

All drivers will earn an "Awards Pin" when they reach a milestone of 100, 250, 500, 750, 1,000, 1,500 or 2,000 hours of cumulative driving.

Logs must be returned to the Hours On The Box Seat coordinator before October 7 each year so the ACDA can prepare awards to be presented at the Annual General Meeting.

There is no fee for this program, but you must be a current member of the Alberta Carriage Driving Association before you start logging your hours and must continue to be a member to keep accumulating hours.
